


The Birches'

Outdoor Visit Fact-Sheet



	<p>Visits outdoors continue to be the most preferred method to safely visit your loved one during COVID-19 unrest. The Birches has designated comfortable areas for outside visitation until we have to reevaluate due to weather.</p>
	<p>Visitation outdoors is only available to residents who are not in isolation or quarantine due to known or suspected COVID-19 infection until a physician discontinues isolation or quarantine orders.</p>
	<p>All visitors are required to self-screen at home prior to their visit using the screening tool posted publicly on our website and emailed to residents and their families. All visitors also are required to pre-screen at the Screening Checkpoint outside the designated Visitation area, and attest in writing that they have passed the screening questionnaire before visiting their loved one.</p>
	<p>Use of hand sanitizer, and hard surface wipes are available and encouraged for all visitors to use throughout their appointment time. Our team will clean and disinfect all items before and after each appointment.</p>
	<p>Visitors only age 16 and older allowed. Maximum of two visitors per appointment time.</p>
	<p>A face covering is required to be worn by all visitors during their entire visit. A plexiglass table-shield is in place during the visit because not all residents are safely able to wear a mask at all times.</p>

	<p>Due to limited accessible space, Outdoor Visitation Appointments are one time per week per resident for no more than 30 minutes. Virtual visitation continues to be an additional alternative.</p>
	<p>Food and Beverages are allowed during visits because The Birches has a table-shield between the resident and their guests, and the tables are 6' wide. Items must be disinfected, and hand wipes are used before and after eating.</p>
	<p>Visitors that develop COVID-19 related symptoms within 5 days after visiting must immediately notify a nurse at The Birches by calling 630-789-1135</p>
	<p>Visitors are not allowed to enter the community, and they are not allowed to go on the other side of the designated plexiglass table-shield during their 30-minute appointment.</p>
	<p><u>Above all else</u>, we hope you enjoy your visit here at The Birches! Have fun, share stories, and enjoy the moments!</p> <p>The Birches community loves to make lemonade when life hands us lemons!</p>
